

APPLICATION FOR A MULTIPLE-ENTRY SHORT-TERM STAY VISA

1. Please check the box for the type of multiple-entry visa you wish to apply for and for which you are eligible.
- General short-term visa (Tourism, etc.)**
 - Have visited Japan for a short-term stay within the past 3 years and have sufficient financial capacity to cover travel expenses (Proof required such as passport stamps, etc.).
 - Have visited Japan for a short-term stay within the past 3 years and have also traveled multiple times to other G7 countries (excluding Japan) (Proof required such as passport stamps, etc.).
 - Person with sufficient financial capacity.
 - Spouse or child of a person with sufficient financial capacity.
 - Short-term stay for business purposes**
 - Full-time employee of a state-owned company.
 - Full-time employee of a company listed on a stock exchange (including companies listed on stock exchanges in third countries/regions other than Japan and Vietnam).
 - Full-time employee of a Japanese-invested company that is a member of the Japanese Chamber of Commerce in Hanoi and has a business office or contact address in Japan (including representative offices).
 - Full-time employee of a joint venture, subsidiary, branch, etc. funded by a company listed on a stock exchange.
 - Full-time employee of a company with a record of ongoing business transactions with a company listed on a Japanese stock exchange.
 - Person in a managerial position who has traveled to Japan for business purposes within the past 3 years and has also traveled multiple times to other G7 countries (excluding Japan) for short-term stays.
 - Person in a managerial position who has traveled to Japan for business purposes three or more times within the past 3 years.
 - Spouse or child of a person who meets one of the above conditions.
 - Short-term visa for cultural figures, intellectuals, etc.**
 - Artist with recognized achievements in fine arts, literature, music, theater, dance, etc., or researcher in social sciences (Literature, law, economics, etc.) or natural sciences (Science, engineering, medicine, etc.).
 - Practicing lawyer, certified public accountant, patent attorney, judicial scrivener, notary public, or medical doctor.
 - Amateur athlete with recognized achievements.
 - Person holding the position of full-time university lecturer or higher.
 - Person holding the position of department head or higher at a state research institute, a national museum, art museum, or library.
 - Member of the National Assembly, central government official, member of a local People's Council, or local government official.
 - Spouse or child of a person who meets one of the above conditions.
 - Short-term stay visa for spouse or child of a Japanese national residing in Vietnam**
 - Currently living with the above-mentioned Japanese national and has previously traveled to Japan (Proof required such as passport stamps, etc.).
 - Applicant holds a nationality other than Vietnamese.

【Important Note 1】 Applicant wishing to apply for a multiple-entry visa must submit supporting documents as proof of meeting the above requirements (e.g., past immigration stamps, information about listed companies on stock exchange, documents proving business transaction records, employment certificate, documents proving professional achievements). Failure to provide such documentation will result in a multiple-entry visa not being granted. However, even in such cases (if other requirements are met), a single-entry visa (or double-entry visa) may still be issued.

【Important Note 2】 Certain nationalities are not eligible for multiple-entry visas.
